DESCRIPTION: Mark is the Manager of Technical Marketing which includes responsibility for partici-

pating in ASHRAE committees including 170 for healthcare facilities. Prior to that role, Mark was the Food and Beverage Segment Manager for Camfil USA with overall responsibility for growing market share in food or beverage production facilities located

throughout the United States.

His background in industrial food processing and healthcare facilities gives Mark the understanding required to select the air filtration solution that provides the appropriate level of indoor air quality while tackling the high cost of energy, fewer maintenance staff and a growing shortage of landfill space. Food processing plants and healthcare facilities have a surprising number of common challenges and a more technical filtration solution strikes the right balance between energy cost, service life longevity while maximizing an HVAC system's airflow capabilities. These solutions typically deliver savings to healthcare facilities of between 6 to 12 cents per

square foot and between 30% and 40% for a typical food processing facility.

New York State Professional Engineers Self Study Ethics PDH Available!


As a licensed professional in New York State, it is your professional responsibility to know the legal and ethical requirements governing the practice of your profession and to be alert to changes in those requirements. The New York State Board for Engineering and Land Surveying, in an effort to help you stay abreast of your professional responsibilities, has developed this short, self-study educational activity in ethics.

This educational activity is based on the New York State Education Law Articles 130 and 145, the Rules of the Board of Regents Parts 1, 3, 17, 18, 28, 29, 31, and the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education Parts 59 and 68. It is strongly recommended that, prior to taking the self test, you review these <u>foundational materials</u> (http://www.op.nysed.gov/prof/pels/pelaw.htm) on the engineering web site.

Once you have reviewed the foundational materials, proceed to complete the self test below. When you have completed the self test, click the "Get your score" button at the bottom of the page. You should print this screen and save it as evidence of satisfactory completion of this educational activity. A score of 90% or greater will allow you to claim 1 Professional Development Hour (PDH) of educational activity credit in ethics ONCE in each three-year registration period. Retain your printed screen for no less than 6 years from the date of completion.


